Elya, Susan Middleton **Eight Animals On the Town** Putnam's, 2000
Eight animals go to market, to supper, and to dance, introducing the numbers from one to eight and vocabulary in English and Spanish.

Martin, Bill **Chicka Chicka Boom Boom** Simon & Schuster, 1989
An Alphabet Rhyme/chant that relates what happens when the whole alphabet tries to climb a coconut tree.

Martin, Bill **Chica Chica Bum Bum** Scholastic, 2002
Spanish language version of Chicka Chicka Boom Boom.

Mora, Pat **Uno, Dos, Tres=One, Two, Three** Clarion, 1996
Pictures depict two sisters going from shop to shop buying birthday presents for their mother. Rhyming text presents numbers from one to ten in English and Spanish.

Scarry, Richard **Richard Scarry's Best Counting Book Ever=El Mejor Libro Para Contar de Richard Scarry** Luna rising, 2004
Introduces the numbers and counting from one to one hundred as Willy Bunny counts all the things he sees in one day.

Shahan, Sherry **Spicy hot colors=colores picantes** August House, 2004
Out of Print. Introduces young readers to colors in Spanish and English by interweaving images and dance moves.
