Santa Project Directions:



Supplies:

Large Paper Plate with popsicle stick attached
Red Paint
Small Paper Plate
Paintbrush (from previous class)
White Construction Paper with hat outline on it
Black Construction Paper
Yellow Construction Paper
Manilla Cardstock Paper with circle drawn on it
Cotton Balls
Goggle Eyes
Red Adhesive Felt
White Adhesive Felt
Tacky Glue
Scissors
Glue Stick
Black Marker

Directions:

1. **Prior to class:** Cut out Santa's hat out of the white construction paper and use your paintbrush, paint it red and let it dry.
2. Cut the circle out of the manila cardstock, using a glue stick glue to down to the center of the back of the large paper plate.
3. Next glue the goggle eyes on manila part of the paper plate.
4. Cut out Santa's mustache using the white adhesive felt. Make a rainbow and then connect both ends. Make two of them. Stick them in the center of the manila circle. You will then place his circle nose of over the top. (Refer to the picture for clarification.)

5. Cut out a circle out of the red adhesive felt for Santa's nose. Stick on over the two end of his mustache. Then use a black marker and make his mouth.
6. Now we are going to make Santa's beard. Pull apart the cotton balls and use your tacky glue to place all along the bottom of the paper plate. Save some cotton balls for Santa's hat.
7. Next glue with a glue stick the black construction on bottom of hat. Cut off the extra black on the sides.
8. Take the yellow construction paper and fold it half and then cut out a small rectangle out on the middle of the fold. This will be Santa's belt buckle on his hat. Glue with a glue stick the buckle in the middle of the black
9. Take 1-2 cotton balls and glue them on the end of the hat. Then glue hat onto Santa's face. Lastly add some cotton balls along the edge of the hat and Santa's face.
