My Five Senses:

This 30 minute educational program includes hands-on learning about the senses we use on a daily basis. The kids will smell, touch, taste, hear, and see many different items and then discuss their findings!

Just One You:

This engaging program offers collaborative art and discusses the beauty in being UNIQUE! Students will listen to a story read by a Museum Educator and then create a self-portrait!

Music:

This 30 minute hands-on educational program incorporates singing, rhythm, literature and language to explore music.

States of Matter:
