



Ladybug Project



Materials Provided:

2 Large White Paper Plates

Black Paint

Paintbrush and Dot Sponge Brush (from previous classes)

Large Sheet of Red Construction Paper

Small Sheet of Black Construction Paper

2 Gold Brads

Pair of Google Eyes

Runny Glue

Glue Stick

Scissor

White Crayon / Pencil

Directions:

Prior to class please have your child paint their paper plate black. Save the rest of the paint for class day so we can create the spots on their ladybug.

1. First cut other paper plate in half. Next have your child start ripping the red construction paper into piece. Then use runny glue to glue down the red paper to both halves of the paper plate. Set that aside to dry
2. Next we are going to make the head of our ladybug. Take the black paper and draw an arch on the end of paper. Make sure it is big enough to place the google eyes on it. (Refer to the picture if needed) Then cut it out. Glue google eyes onto the black paper. Glue head onto the top of the painted black plate.
3. Next use the brads to attach the ladybug's wings. You can use either one or two.
4. Our final step is to add our ladybug's spots. Your child can decide how many they would like to put on it. Using your circle sponge dotter, dip it in the black paint and dot your ladybug's wings. Then let dry!
